AGREEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING
between
Kansas Wesleyan University
and
Hesston College

This articulation agreement is entered into between Hesston College and Kansas Wesleyan University.

Kansas Wesleyan University assures the acceptance of any Hesston College Associate of Arts (AA) and Associate of Science (AS) graduate as a baccalaureate degree-seeking student with junior standing. **Further, Kansas Wesleyan assures Hesston graduates their credits will transfer as a block to cover all needed general education requirements.**

Interested Students should note:

1. To graduate from Kansas Wesleyan, transfer students must meet all other prerequisite, program, degree, and residency requirements as described in the KWU Academic Catalog. In order to assure transparency, when a Hesston student applies for admission, Kansas Wesleyan will analyze her or his transcript and create an individualized academic work report reflecting exactly what remains to earn a Bachelor degree.
2. Students with other degrees from Hesston College are not included in this agreement. KWU welcomes those students, but will assess their transcripts on an individual basis.
3. Hesston College students will receive full consideration for all forms of federal, state, and institutional financial aid, based on results of their Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) data and their cumulative Hesston GPA. Transfer students will also be eligible for housing in KWU dorms, and other student services, such as academic advising and the Student Success Center.
4. Hesston College and Kansas Wesleyan University will include information about this agreement in their college publications.
5. This agreement replaces any previous agreement. It may be terminated by either party with notice of at least one year.






