NOTICE TO EJECTED INTRAMURAL PARTICIPANT

All participants, coaches, and spectators who choose to participate in the Intramural Sports Program at Kansas Wesleyan University are expected to act in a sportsmanlike manner and comply with the spirit, as well as the letter of the rules, of each sport.

Any participant, coach, or spectator who is ejected from any Intramural Sports Program, regardless of the reason, is **SUSPENDED INDEFINITELY** from participation in all sponsored Intramural Sports events until reinstatement by the Intramural Sports Office.

The following procedure must be followed for any player seeking reinstatement into Intramural Sports:

1. Intramural Supervisor gives this information sheet to the ejected player OR to the team captain.
2. Player is to be removed from the facility. Failure to leave the area/facility may result in disqualification of the team captain, or forfeiture of the game.
3. Ejected participant is suspended from any and all intramural activities until reinstated by the Director.
4. A meeting must be set-up between the ejected participant, the team captain, and the Director of Intramurals within **ONE WEEK OF THE EJECTION**. Failure to do so will result in indefinite suspension from intramural sports for up to one academic year.
5. The player seeking to be reinstated must submit a letter to the Director of Intramurals explaining why they should be reinstated.
6. A decision will be made by the Director of Intramurals on the appropriate actions for each case.
7. The decision made by the Director will be sent by email to the ejected participant and the team captain within 48 hours.

*Any player that is ejected will serve a mandatory one (1) game suspension

**Any participation by an ejected player before a meeting is set with the Director will be forfeited.

***Any second occurrence of unsportsmanlike conduct by a team may result in the team's forfeiture of the remainder of the season.

****If a player wishes to have witnesses speak on their behalf, they are welcomed.

*****Conduct subject to discipline may include, but are not limited to: offensive language, attempting to start a conflict, physical abuse, not playing within the spirit of the rules, cheating or deception, using illegal players, and officials' abuse.

*****Discipline rulings may include, but are not limited to, probation, game/league suspension, lifetime expulsion, exclusion from athletic facilities, community service, and fines. The Intramural Sports program reserves the right to sanction individuals and teams.
