1. For admission consideration to the University return the following to the **Office of Admissions**
  - a. Application for admission to Kansas Wesleyan University
  - b. \$20.00 Application Fee (for **KWU application only**)
  - c. Official High School Transcript
  - d. Official ACT or SAT scores (if fewer than 15 transferable college or university hours)
  - e. Official Transcript for **every credit hour from EVERY college or university attended**
  
2. For admission consideration to the **BSN** program of the Division of Nursing Education (a fee is not required for the Division of Nursing Education application)
  - a. Accepted by the University
  - b. Cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.6 or better on a 4.0 scale, including all previous college work required for admission to nursing
  - c. Completion of all prenursing courses with a grade of C or better
  - d. Completion of NURS250 Introduction to Professional Nursing and NURS260 Information Management with grades of C or better
