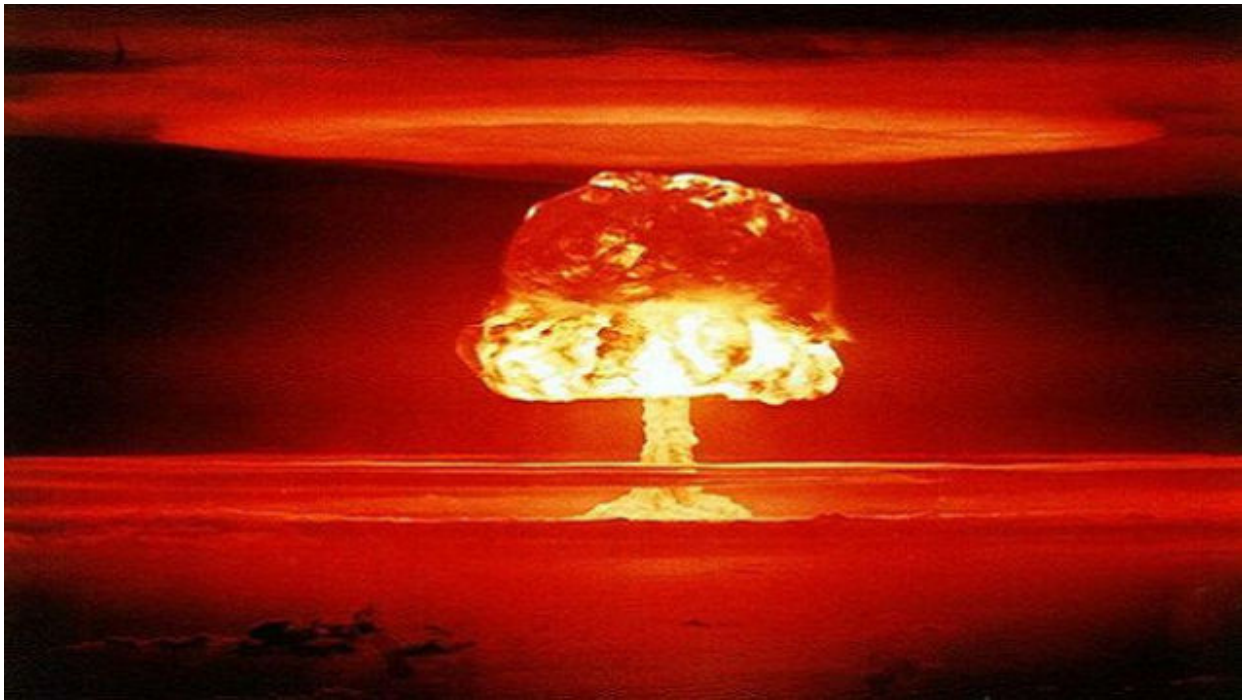

**HIST350 -- Making History: Great Events and Turning

“The Cold War”**

“Making History -- Great Events and Turning Points that Influenced the World” is a rotating topics course that investigates important events, ideas, and decisions in history that have influenced, even changed, the world. The course focuses on cause and effect, achievement and failure, and lessons learned throughout history. This course satisfies one Liberal Studies requirement for Community and World Exploration. Prerequisite: ENGL120 or equivalent.

This course subtopic -- “The Cold War” is an overview of the political, military, and socio-economic history of the 2nd half of the 20th century with an emphasis on the ideological clash between the United States, the Soviet Union, and China and how it influenced world affairs.
