



Vanier Family Scholarship Competition for Teacher Education

November 1, 2018

High school seniors or students transferring into KWU who declare a teacher education major are eligible to compete for a Vanier Family Scholarship. These renewable, 4-year scholarships provide \$20,000 annually to promising future teachers. To compete, a student must have a 3.0 GPA (high school or transfer) and a 21 ACT (or equivalent) score.

- 1) Application cover, signed by student and parent/guardian
- 2) A short personal statement (200-500 words max) that explains why you want to become a teacher
- 3) Transcript of grades through last semester
- 4) ACT or SAT score documentation
- 5) Two letters of recommendation from teachers on school letterhead

All materials must be submitted prior to October 22, 2018

What qualities does a teacher need to have?

What is your work ethic?

What qualities do you possess?
