## Your Admission Checklist

- Apply For Admission**  
Apply online at [www.kwu.edu](http://www.kwu.edu) or mail your application. We will waive the \$20 application fee if you join us for a campus visit.
- Submit Your Transcripts**  
You must submit official transcripts from your high school and all colleges/universities you have attended. Official transcripts must be either mailed or sent electronically from the issuing institution to the Office of Admissions.
- Submit Your ACT or SAT Scores**  
Submission of official ACT or SAT scores is required for incoming freshmen. Test scores must be either sent directly from the testing agency to the Office of Admissions or listed on your official high school transcript.

## Admissions Requirements

### Freshman

A 2.5 cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale and a minimum ACT Composite score of 18 or SAT composite score of 960 (ERW+M)

### Transfer\*

A minimum 2.5 GPA with 24 or more credit hours; transfer students with fewer than 24 credit hours must meet the freshman requirements.

### GED

A GED score of 550 is required for admission with an ACT composite score of 18 or SAT composite score of 960 (ERW+M); scores should be sent directly from the State Board of Education to the Office of Admissions.

## Your Next Steps

- Check Your Application Status**  
Check your application status and view any incomplete items on your MyKWU student portal under the student tab. Log onto to your MyKWU at [www.kwu.edu](http://www.kwu.edu) with your user ID and temporary password that will be sent via email after you apply. If you forget your MyKWU student login, please contact the Office of Admissions at 785-833-4305.
- Apply For Financial Aid**  
Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as soon as possible after Oct. 1. **KWU's Federal Code is 001929**. When filing your FAFSA, make sure to use the IRS Date Retrieval Tool to transfer your tax information into FAFSA. After you submit your FAFSA, wait four business days and then log onto [MyKWU Student Portal > Financial Information > Document Tracking](#) to view your next steps.

- Accepted Students**  
Once accepted, review your financial aid award package and submit your non-refundable fee (\$200 for full-time students and \$100 for part-time students). Full-time students must also complete the residence life forms (residence hall application, health form).
- Register for SOAR**  
Visit [www.kwu.edu/SOAR](http://www.kwu.edu/SOAR) to register for a Summer Orientation Advising and Registration (SOAR) day where you will register for classes and spend a fun day with future Coyotes, parents, faculty and staff. You will receive notification by mail to confirm your SOAR registration.
