In order to process your student’s financial aid application, the Office of Student Financial Planning needs a copy of each of your (and your spouse’s) 2019 W-2 forms. The W-2 Form is the document your employer is required to forward to you. IRS rules require that employers provide the W-2 forms to you by January 31st each year.

You will not be able to receive a Financial Aid award offer until this issue is resolved.

What do I have to do so I can still receive Financial Aid, if I do not have a copy of my W-2?

1	Obtain a duplicate copy from each of your 2019 employer(s).	Please collect all W-2 forms and submit them to the Office of Student Financial Planning...all at one time. Thank you!
2	Download a copy (Transcript) of your 2019 Wage and Income Transcript from the IRS Website.	https://www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript

Once all the W-2 forms are received by the Office of Student Financial Planning, we will review and update documents in your myKWU portal as quickly as possible.
