Undergraduate students who have participated in the College Board Advanced Placement Program in high school may earn college credit as detailed below.

A maximum of 30 credit hours may be granted for the combination of credit for prior learning, military experience, field experience, credit by exam, advanced placement program (AP), international baccalaureate (IB), and college-level examination program (CLEP) for undergraduate students.
