

Student Loan Entrance Counseling

1. Go to www.studentaid.gov



- 2. Entrance Counseling is a brief (about 20 minutes) financial literacy training program that will familiarize you with the features, benefits, and responsibilities you take on when you accept federal student loans.
- 3. On the upper part of the website, you will see (Complete Aid Process), select drop down and you will see Complete Entrance Counseling. Click this and it will take you to Complete Your Student Loan Entrance Counseling requirement. You will select, Undergraduate Student and select Start.

Understand your repayment obligation and what it means to take out a federal student loan.




