Student Quarantine Expectations & Guidelines

- 1. You should expect to remain on the quarantine property at all times unless on a pre-approved errand. Example: students should not leave the property to visit a friend, but students would be allowed to leave to pick up ClickList items from Dillons.
- 2. Students should not congregate in others' rooms while in quarantine, nor should any unsupervised mass gatherings take place.

Example: students should not congregate by the pool, but socially distanced University activities will be available and will be conducted safely.

- 3. Guests are not permitted while students are in quarantine.
- 4. At any time, when in quarantine and while classes are in session, class work is paramount and students should expect to be in class, virtually, to fully participate.
- 5. All property rules should be followed, as well as all Kansas Wesleyan University regulations related to student conduct and housing. Any damages will be the responsibility of the student, and no inappropriate behavior will be tolerated.
- 6. Students should expect a high level of engagement with KWU faculty and staff throughout the quarantine process, including phone calls, as well as options for outdoor, socially distanced activities and spiritual development. You should never feel like you're alone during quarantine.
- 7. KWU coaches and activity providers will provide conditioning and activity training plans for students while in quarantine.
- 8. Unless told otherwise, face coverings should be worn at all times when leaving the quarantine room.
- 9. Prior to quarantine, students must make arrangements to pay for meals while in quarantine.
- 10. During quarantine, Kansas Wesleyan University Information Systems staff may be available, during business hours, to provide technical support for University-related activity via email and phone. No support will occur in person, at the quarantine site.
